Lazarus House continues to provide much-needed groceries for our Guests in the new “Grab ‘n Go Groceries” format. We must comply with City regulations and work in a manner that keeps our Staff and Guests safe. We are serving up to 1200 families that come through our St. Martha’s Food Pantry each week – **and we need your help.** As you know, we rely on the many food drives you have generously managed in the past to provide nutritious and culturally relevant food to our Guests. During this crisis, understandably, those have come to a halt as we knew them. However, we still need to serve the increasing number of vulnerable Guests struggling with food insecurity who rely on us to feed their families.

YOU can make a huge difference for these families!

HERE’S HOW YOU CAN HELP:

1. Arrange your neighborhood Community Cares Food Drive by promoting the event and rally your sphere of influence to support this COVID-19-safe way to collect the food our Guests need.
2. Call or email your neighbors and friends and ask them to purchase the “Needed Items Below”, bag them and put out on their porch, steps, or stoop on a given day/time for you to pick up.
3. Ask participants to purchase only the NEEDED ITEMS (listed below) and specify NO GLASS. Please also encourage NEW food purchases to help us save precious time in sorting out “best by” dates
4. You can safely go around (please wear gloves and mask) to pick them up and put into your trunk
5. Drop the bags of food at LAZARUS HOUSE FOOD PANTRY (242 Hampshire Street, Lawrence)

7. **IDEAS:** Bring music, make signs, use this event to bring your community closer for a great cause, take pictures, share on social media, invite the local newspaper to cover the story
